## **COVID Report:**

Covid-19 cases across LA County seem to have stabilized although still quite high.

Within the past 2 weeks (5/26-6/8), the Acton and Agua-Dulce surrounding areas, saw 42 new cases.

In our school community, we have had 3 positive cases reported to us since 6/8/2022 and the Department of Public Health has released High Desert from its Outbreak status as of 6/17/2022.

We have officially moved over to Primary Health and are no longer taking tests through the Color Laboratories.
