COVID Report:

• As of 02/22/23, Los Angeles County is in the "low" category for CDC COVID-19 Community Levels.

 \cdot In the Low category, masking is strongly recommended in indoor public places if you are at risk for severe illness

• In the Acton and Agua-Dulce surrounding areas there have been 4 new cases of Covid-19 since our last report on March 9th.

 \cdot In our AADUSD school community there have been 2 positive cases reported since 3/9/2023, and exposure notifications have been sent for those affected.

• California State changed the guidelines listed in the T1 & T2 appendixes which are posted at each school and the district offices. Students and Teachers are subject to different rules so if you are in Isolation or receive a close contact letter please read it carefully.

• We want to encourage parents to test their students for Covid if they have any symptoms and keep them home for fever above 1000, vomiting, or unusual new cough. Once they are symptom-free for 24 hours they may return.

 \cdot Home test kits are available at all school sites, at your local pharmacy using your Medical/Medicare card, or check with your insurance.

 \cdot Our Test kit funding expires in June. We will continue to hand out test kits after June if we have the supply to do so.
